SUBJECT: Parental Bereavement Leave

This memorandum provides guidance on parental bereavement leave, a new paid leave established by the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2022 (see section 1111 of Public Law 117-81, December 27, 2021, codified under 5 U.S.C. 6329d). Under 5 U.S.C. 6329d, covered Federal employees are entitled to 2 workweeks of parental bereavement leave in connection with the death of an employee's qualifying child. This new provision became effective on December 27, 2021.
